Background Summary

Lily of the Valley was initially established in 1993 in response to the HIV/AIDS pandemic as a hospice for children in the KWAZULU-NATAL area, providing palliative care.

Lily of the Valley registered as a Non-profit Organization in 2000 and is also registered as a Child and Youth Care Centre with the Department of Social Development, caring for and raising orphaned and vulnerable children.

We are able to accommodate up to 85 children. We currently have 82 children in our care.

WHY MOVE *the Village?*

Relocating an entire village of children & building a new village in a different location strikes as an ambitious, costly & seemingly unattainable undertaking.

What motivates consideration for such a project?

Christian Care Centre, operating as Lily of the Valley Children's Village has evolved significantly over the years.

With advancements in medication, the children under its care began to thrive, prompting a shift from mere survival to fostering brighter futures for each child as they grow, develop, and eventually reintegrate into family and society.

Despite its effectiveness in the early years, the current location presents many challenges.



Limited access to QUALITY EDUCATION & AMENITIES.



Prevalent CRIME, making it UNSAFE for children & staff.



No access to WATER & LOGISTICAL difficulties.



Plus our access to shops & hospitals is limited, & the area experiences poor WiFi services. Additionally, volunteer access is restricted.

This gives us time to raise the remaining funds needed to bring this vision to life — creating a safer, more sustainable home for our children, closer to quality schools and essential services.

1 x Education Centre – Hall, 4 x Classrooms, IT Room, Toilet & kitchen facilities.



Sporting facilities – full size soccer field, netball, sports facilities (+ swimming pool), open areas & play areas.



Beautiful gardens, play areas and gathering places.



Security Guard House + Electric fencing, security CCTV, Internal fencing.



Renovations to current 5 houses to convert to offices & staff accommodation.



Workshop Spaces – for artisan trade training for our children.
